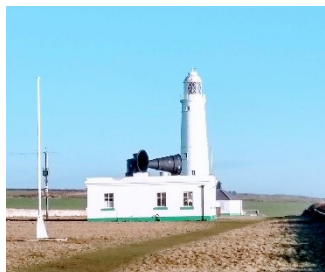


Vale of Glamorgan Walking Festival 2020



Walk Name St Donat's Castle, cliffs and lighthouses

Charge £3 per adult



Walk Details: We will start walking through the leafy nature reserve following Marcross Brook, a short stretch of road then crossing fields with views of Nash Point Lighthouses and the Bristol Channel. Then enter the grounds of St Donat's castle and a glimpse of the castle itself. We will continue through a playing field to follow the cliff tops with more views of the castle and continue through woodland and cliff tops to the impressive lighthouses and fog horns before returning to the start point.
