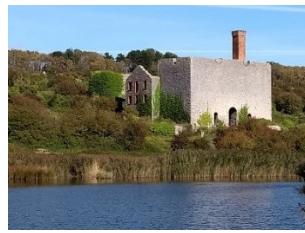


# Vale of Glamorgan Walking Festival 2020



**Name of Walk:** Ponds and Coast Dog Friendly Walk

**Charge:** £3 Per adult, children free, dogs free too



**Walk Details:** This is the event for the whole family with your children and dogs well entertained. You may have to keep them well behaved for a few minutes as we pass through the caravan park but after we have counted the steps down to the reserve where there is a beach and plenty of paths for the kids and dogs to explore as we walk to the mouth of River Thaw returning around the lake, nature reserve and historic manufacturing buildings.
