

# Vale of Glamorgan Walking Festival 2020



**Name of Walk: Around Penllyn**

**Charge: £3 per adult**



**Walk Details:** Leaving Penllyn we will walk across fields to Llangan, pass the Church and head on uphill to a wind turbine and transmitters. We will follow the crest of the hill to St Mary Church and Ruthin Common and its quarries and limekiln continuing downhill to Graig Penllyn. Skirting round a hill to enter the Thaw valley following the escarpment and eventually ascending it to return to Penllyn.

**Hospitality:** The Red Fox Inn, a discounted “walker’s Menu” will be available.

## TRAVEL & PARKING

**Car:** A48, at the junction 1 mile west of Cowbridge follow signs to Penllyn. The pub is on the main road through the village.

**Public transport:** X2 from Cardiff or Bridgend, take the stop near the paintball signs a half mile walk to Penllyn.

**FREE PARKING:** At the pub or roadside.
