TRAVEL & PARKING

Travel Directions: A4231 to Barry Dock. Continue straight through the roundabout, turn right in the bottom of the dip onto Coldbrook Road East, continue to left hand fork up Church Road to the top of the hill then turn left. (Look for the brown tourist signs). Immediately turn left again and the main gate to the park will be on your right about 150m along Sea View Terrace.

Public Transport:

Bus: Nearest stop The Royal, Barry Rd, 100m from park.

Rail: Nearest station is Cadoxton, 150m from park.
