

Vale of Glamorgan Walking Festival 2020



Name of Walk: Vale Farms and Villages

Charge: £3 per adult



Walk Details: This is a typical Vale walk: following stretches of narrow road then entering farm fields, over narrow streams passing farm buildings new and old, up and over hills with marvellous views atop. This walk takes from the small village of Llanmaes across fields to Llanmihangel Place dating back to the C12th and onto the village of Llandough. Following a ridge with views to the north and south we pass through Sigingstone and onto the now derelict Great Frampton on our return to Llanmaes.

TRAVEL & PARKING

Car: Llanmaes is situated a short distance to the north of the B4265 at Llantwit Major.

Train: Hourly to Llantwit Major station, then approx. 1 mile along Llanmaes Road.

Bus: 303 hourly nearest stop at the railway station. Possible change onto the 304 bus.

304 hourly nearest stop at the Eagleswell Rd/ Llanmaes Rd junction.

321 hourly nearest stop at Whiteways on Llanmaes Rd.

Free Parking: At pub and roadside on Tyle House Close.
